## Waddell & Reed Kansas City Marathon with Ivy Funds Health & Fitness Expo open to the general public

KANSAS CITY, MO (September 28, 2015) – The Waddell & Reed Kansas City Marathon with Ivy Funds will kick-off marathon weekend October 15 and 16 with a free Health & Fitness Expo. Over 90 vendors from around the country will share their merchandise and expertise with an expected 20,000 attendees. In addition to the vendors, all race participants will pick up their race packets at the Expo.

Expo hours are Thursday, October 15, 3-8 p.m. and Friday, October 16, 11 a.m. – 8 p.m. The Expo is located at the Crown Center Exhibit Hall A, 2323 McGee Street, which is connected to the Sheraton at the north end of Crown Center. Parking is free with validation (up to 3 hours).

New this year, Charlie Hustle will have a strong presence selling a Kansas City Marathon custom designed T-shirt. The Charlie Hustle brand has a local vintage flavor that will add a different twist to the other official marathon merchandise.

The Waddell & Reed Kansas City Marathon with Ivy Funds includes a full marathon, half marathon, five-kilometer run, marathon relay and a kids marathon.
