Pilgrims vs. Turkeys compete at 26th Annual Thanksgiving Day 5K Run

KANSAS CITY, MO (September 28, 2015) –It's a battle of the pilgrims and the turkeys at the 26th annual Thanksgiving Day 5K & Family Stroll held at the Sprint Campus in Overland Park. The new course will roll through the Sprint Campus and nearby neighborhood and features a Krispy Kreme Doughnut Aid Station.

"It is a lot of fun to see the many families year after year who have included this event as a Thanksgiving Day family tradition," said Sarah Dee, Events Department Director. "We appreciate everyone who spends Thanksgiving morning with us."

Participants will receive a print-on-demand long-sleeve T-shirt and participants will be randomly assigned to either Team Pilgrim or Team Turkey. The teams will compete against each other and the team that finishes with the best overall time will have bragging rights for a year. Walkers and strollers are welcome at this family-friendly event.
