



## Chiefs Kingdom Champions Parade Full Details

For Immediate Release: Feb. 13, 2023

The City of Kansas City, Kansas City Sports Commission and the Kansas City Chiefs invite all fans to a Chiefs Kingdom Champions Parade and victory rally in downtown KCMO.

The two-mile-long parade starts at 12:00 p.m. Wednesday, Feb. 15. The parade begins on Grand Boulevard at 6<sup>th</sup> street and heads south to Pershing Road. The parade turns west on Pershing Road to Union Station. The victory rally stage will be in front of Union Station, with the National WWI Museum and Memorial hosting viewing opportunities on its north lawn. The victory rally starts at approximately 1:45 p.m., shortly after the parade ends.

### Spectator Information:

- **Watch the parade** anywhere along the route. Barricades will line the entire route along the curb. Pedestrian crossings are marked on the map, but they will be closed while the parade is in progress.
- **Watch the victory rally** in front of Union Station from Pershing Road (which will be closed) or the lawn of the National World War I Museum and Memorial.
- **Arrive early** to find a spot. This will be a family-friendly event, and fans are reminded that public consumption of alcoholic beverages is prohibited. Remember it's best to travel light and to not bring bags or backpacks.
- **Medical Stations and Lost Child Locations** are noted on the parade maps.
- **Children's contact info** – Ensure that your children have contact information for their parents or guardians on their person.
- **Make a plan** in case you are separated from your family, including identifying meet up points.
- **Cell phone reception** will be extremely limited.
- **Union Station** will be closed to the public.
- **Don't bring drones.** Federal law prohibits the use of drones over parade crowds.
- **Officially licensed merchandise** will be available at the following locations:
  - Crown Center Square
  - Pershing & Main
  - Pershing and Kessler

Park and Ride shuttles will run from 7:30 a.m.-11:00 a.m., and then again from 12 p.m. to 4:30 p.m.. Riders need to return to the drop off location for their specific shuttle.

Spectators are advised to carpool and use public transportation. Parking will be extremely limited near the parade and rally.

Kansas City Streetcar will suspend operation beginning at midnight prior to the parade and will reopen as soon as conditions allow.

**Closed Streets:**

- Grand Boulevard from Berkley Park to Pershing Road, starting Tuesday at 12 p.m.
- All east-west streets between Walnut and McGee from Berkley Park to Pershing Road, starting Tuesday 12 p.m.
  - Some vehicle crossings will remain open until Wednesday 9 a.m.
- Main Street from 20<sup>th</sup> Street to Pershing Road will be closed to vehicles **and** pedestrians.



- Main Street from Pershing Road to 31<sup>st</sup> Street will be closed to vehicles, but open to pedestrians.
- Kessler Road from Pershing to the west side of the National WWI Museum and Memorial.

**Accessibility:**

Parade producers have designated space in Crown Center Square for wheelchairs and ADA accessibility. Please be advised that space is limited and is first come, first served.
