## Big 12 Conference keeps Men's Basketball Championship in Kansas City

KANSAS CITY, MO (May 28, 2015) - The Kansas City Sports Commission is pleased to announce that the Big 12 Conference has chosen Kansas City as the host site for the Phillips 66 Big 12 Men's Basketball Championship for 2017-2020.
"We are thrilled that the Big 12 Conference has decided to keep the Men's Basketball Championship in Kansas City," said Kathy Nelson, President \& CEO. "We have a wonderful local host committee made up of volunteers who have given their time over the years to make the Championship successful."

Kansas City was not selected as a host city for the Big 12 Women's Basketball Championship but was awarded the Big 12 Wrestling Championship for 2016, which will be held at Sprint Center. Kansas City has never hosted the Big 12 Wrestling Championship.
