## Anticipation builds for Phillips 66 Big 12 Women's Basketball Championship

*Single-session tickets now on sale; media credential applications currently open*

KANSAS CITY, MO (February 9, 2022) – Single-session tickets are currently on sale for the 2022 Phillips 66 Big 12 Women's Basketball Championship in Kansas City, Missouri. The championship will be held at Municipal Auditorium from March 10-13, as the venue hosts the event for the 13th time.

Reserved seats are available for \$25, and general admission seating is \$10 for each of the five sessions, before applicable service charges. All-session tickets (\$90 reserved, \$50 general admission) remain available. All individuals ages two and up must have a ticket.

"The Phillips 66 Big 12 Women's Basketball Championship represents an incredible opportunity for basketball enthusiasts to see highly competitive play at a compelling price point," says Kathy Nelson, President & CEO of the Kansas City Sports Commission. "As we commemorate the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Title IX, we are committed to inspiring the next generation of athletes and fans through events that showcase the excellence of women's athletics."

Additionally, media credential applications are now open for the 2022 Phillips 66 Big 12 Men's and Women's Basketball Championships. There are separate credentials for each event. Consequently, journalists covering men's and women's games will need to complete both registration links. The deadline for men's credential application ([click here](#)) is **March 1 at 5 p.m. CT**, while the deadline for women's credential application ([click here](#)) is **March 2 at 5 p.m. CT**.

The media hotel for both Championships will be the Courtyard Marriott Downtown at a rate of \$199. A media shuttle will return this year and run from the media hotel to both arenas. A limited number of parking will be available, only for local media, in nearby parking garages.

Please note: COVID policies continue to be in place, and it is requested that media wear masks while covering the Championships.
