Camp WIN to be Hosted over Four Weeks at Sites Throughout the Metro Area - Seeking Coaches & Instructors -

KANSAS CITY, MO (May 20, 2021) – For over 15 years, <u>WIN for KC</u> has hosted <u>Camp WIN</u> presented by Royals Charities – a week-long sports camp that introduces girls ages 6-12 to approximately 14 different sports & fitness activities. Participants also learn daily lessons that help ensure campers walk away with life skills that can translate both on, and off, the field.

In a new format offered for 2021, Camp WIN will be hosted in smaller groups (approximately 50 girls per location) over four sessions at the locations below.

Camp WIN is seeking <u>coaches and instructors</u> from local universities, colleges, high schools and other area organizations to help instruct campers on different sports and fitness activities. Instructors will be given one-hour time slots to teach campers the basics of their sport or fitness activity. Sessions will feature more traditional sports such as volleyball, basketball and soccer as well as other fitness activities such as dance, cheer and yoga.

"We're excited to offer so many different locations this year," says Jessica Blubaugh, Director of WIN for KC. "And that also means we need many more coaches and instructors to lend their support in making sure our participants have the best experience possible."
